Thank you once again for allowing us to participate in the fundraising efforts of the Ducky Wucky Race. We have raised almost \$11,000 over the three years, which represents a very significant \$22,000 after matching. You have also contributed over \$8,000 for the purchase of equipment. This puts you among our most elite donors.

We would specifically like to thank Rich Tuzzolo for coordinating the effort on behalf of the Trust. We also want to recognize those members of the Trust who actively helped selling tickets.

As you may know, the playground was just completed. The track has a base coat of pavement and awaits warmer weather for the final surfacing, which we still hope will occur this month. The soccer field has irrigation installed and has been seeded. Grass is starting to grow. There are still final touches to be done, but the park should be open for the public within a month, thanks in large part to you.

Fundraising continues, though we have now met our initial goal of \$1,100,000. We are trying to establish an endowment and board of trustees for the long term care of the park.

We will be having an opening of the park later this month and a formal dedication late next spring. You are all invited. We will provide details later.
